

# AWARDS AND PRIZES

Attractive prizes and awards have been instituted for meritorious performances in University and College Examinations. Awards have also been instituted for outstanding performance in co-curricular activities and sports. In case of extra- ordinary achievements, the College also rewards the students with Medals, College Colors, Trophies, Merit Certificates and maintains a Roll of Honour. The prizes in the form of mementoes, books along with certificates are awarded as per the College Reward Policy mentioned in the Prospectus of the year of admission.

## I. PRIZES IN ACADEMICS

### 1. UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS:

**Prizes for Performance in Aggregates in each Semester:** Meritorious students showcasing outstanding performance in University Examinations will be awarded following prizes.

#### 1.1 First to Fifth Semesters (individually)

## **2. MID SEMESTER TESTS (MSTs)**

The following prizes (in the form of Books and Merit Certificates) will be awarded to the students for their performance in Mid Semester Tests (MSTs):

\* In the paper of History and Culture of Punjab, only the combined topper from B.Com and BBA first semester will be eligible for subject topper prize.

### **Eligibility Criteria for prizes mentioned above**

- A minimum attendance of 75% in aggregates.
- Since Prize distribution function is organized during the even semester, therefore, for finalizing prize winners list, the attendance upto MSTs will be considered.
- For any prize in Aggregate, a student must have obtained at least 80% marks in B.Com Course and 75% marks each in B.B.A. and B Com Hons. Course.

- For any prize as a subject topper, a student will be eligible for the prize provided at least 70% marks in B.Com course and 65% marks in B.B.A course have been obtained in that particular subject and he/ she has not failed in any other subject.

USE OF UNFAIR MEANS OR ANY OTHER ACT OF MISCONDUCT DURING MSTs WILL AUTOMATICALLY RENDER A STUDENT INELIGIBLE FOR THE AWARD OF ANY PRIZE FOR THAT SEMESTER.

**Credit for Participation in Outside Events Representing the College:**

In case any student is sent to participate in any Sports or Extra Curricular event outside the College during Mid Semester Tests, such student will be given exemption from specified subject exams. Later, for the purpose of determination of prizes in the MSTs, the said student will have to appear in re-test for that particular subject(s) at the time of conduct of Special Test.

## II. PRIZES IN SPORTS

The following prizes (in the form of sports material) will be awarded to the students for their performance in sports:

**1. Inter College/ District / University/ State/ Inter University/ National Level Events:**

Note: For any team event, the team means playing members as well as reserve members.

**2. Intra College Sports Events:**

The students standing First in various Intra College Events (team as well as individual events) including the students standing First, Second and Third in Run for Fitness (separately for boys and girls) will be given mementoes at the Annual Athletic Meet.

The participants in these intra college sports events will be shortlisted on the basis of their performance in a minimum of five practice sessions or heats organized before the final sports event takes place.

### 3. Best Athlete (separately in the Boys and Girls Category):

The students who are adjudged the Best Athlete (in boys and girls category separately) in the Annual Athletic and Sports Meet will be awarded prize of Rs.1000 in the form of suitable sports material, memento and merit certificate at the Annual Prize Distribution Function.

## **III. PRIZES IN CO- CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Co-curricular Activities include the events organized at the Inter College level, Panjab University Youth Festivals and higher levels viz. Musical, Theatrical, Fine Arts, Dance, Literary and Heritage Events. The prizes in this category will be given as follows:

### 1. Youth Festivals and Inter College Competitions:

A student getting prizes in Youth Festivals, Inter College Competitions and the student who is adjudged as Best Camper in University Level Leadership Camps will be awarded prizes in the form of books as per details given below:

\* MUN winners will be honoured with following awards:

- i) Chairperson / Best Delegate equivalent to First Prize of any inter college event.
- ii) Vice Chairperson / High Commendation equivalent to Second Prize of any inter college event.
- iii) Rapporteur / Special Mention equivalent to Third Prize of any inter college event.

## **2. Intra College Competitions:**

### **(i) Inter Section Subject Quiz:**

In order to inculcate the habit of regular study among students , Class Wise Inter Section Subject Quizzes are organized. The highest individual scorers (level wise) and the members of the team getting the highest team score will be rewarded at the Annual Prize Distribution Function with mementoes and certificates.

### **(ii) Independent Thinking Exercise:**

The Top Three participants coming out with the best ideas in the Independent Thinking will be rewarded in the Annual Prize Distribution Function with mementoes and certificates.

### **(iii) Sri Aurobindo Birth Anniversary cum Paper Reading Competition:**

The student obtaining First, Second and Third positions will be awarded mementoes and certificates at the Annual Prize Distribution Function.

### **(iv) Cultural Fest cum Talent Hunt Competition:**

The College organizes an Inter Class Cultural Fest cum Talent Hunt Competition in musical, theatrical, fine arts, dance, literary and heritage events. The students obtaining First, Second and Third positions will be awarded merit certificates at the time of conclusion of event and the First Prize winners will also be awarded mementoes at the Annual Prize Distribution Function.

### **(v) Marketing and Finance Fest – ‘Mettle’:**

The teams obtaining First, Second, Third positions, winner of Best Mettle Social Responsibility (MSR) and Best Promotion will be awarded merit certificates at the time of conclusion of event and the First Prize winners will also be awarded mementoes at the Annual Prize Distribution Function.

### **(vi) British Parliamentary Debate (BPD):**

The students obtaining First position in the British Parliamentary Debate will be awarded mementoes and Certificate at the Annual Prize Distribution Function.

### **(vii) Public Speaking Programme(PSP):**

The student obtaining First position in the Public Speaking Programme will be awarded memento and Certificate at the time of conclusion of PSP.

### **(viii) Model United Nations (MUN):**

The Jury members and Best Delegate will be awarded memento and certificate at the time of conclusion of MUN.

ANY CONTEST THAT HAS A COMMERCIAL ELEMENT IN IT WHEREIN PRIZES ARE SPONSORED BY AN ORGANIZATION OTHER THAN SACCM, PRIZE WINNERS SHALL NOT BE PRESENTED AWARDS IN THE ANNUAL PRIZE DISTRIBUTION FUNCTION.

## **IV. ADDITIONAL PRIZES**

**The students will be awarded with Merit Certificates and Mementoes for the following prizes in the Annual Prize Distribution Function**

- i. Best Attendance in each semester separately with a minimum of 95% attendance. Besides this, the student should have passed in all the subjects in the Mid Semester Tests of that semester.\*
- ii. Best NSS Volunteer (separately in boys and girls category)\*\*

\*Since Annual Prize Distribution Function is organized during the even semester, therefore, for finalizing Best Attendance prize winner, the attendance upto MSTs will be considered.

\*\*Best NSS Volunteer will be selected on the basis of following criteria:

- Total number of hours spent by a volunteer in various NSS activities or
- Number of times a volunteer took part in a particular NSS activity during the session or
- Continuous performance in a particular NSS activity

## **V. APPRECIATION CERTIFICATES**

Appreciation certificates will be given to the members of Student Council, members of Nukkad Natak, Creative Forum and organizing team members of other Intra College events/ activities on the basis of recommendation by respective activity in-charges as per their performance in organizing the events.

### **CRITERIA FOR ACADEMIC ROLL OF HONOUR AND COLLEGE COLOR**

**Roll of Honour in Academics and College Color in Extra Curricular Activities and Sports will be awarded to the Students of the Passed out Batch.**

#### **ACADEMIC ROLL OF HONOUR\***

The Academic Roll of Honour\* will be awarded as per the following criteria:

1. Students obtaining any of the Top Three University Positions in Aggregates in B.Com/ B.B.A (Aggregate of all semesters) in University Exams will be awarded the Roll of Honour irrespective of the marks obtained .
2. A student obtaining the Gold Medal (First Position in University) in B.Com Hons.- Business Finance and Accounting/ Marketing Management (Aggregate of IIIrd, IVth, Vth and VIth semesters) irrespective of the marks obtained.

\*For award of Academic Roll of Honour to the students in semester system classes, the aggregate result of all the six semesters in B Com/ BBA course and aggregate result of IIIrd, IVth, Vth and VIth semesters in B Com Hons. Course will be considered.

## **COLLEGE COLOR IN EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

### **ACTIVITIES COVERED**

1. Fine Arts Events, Musical Events, Theatrical Events, Dance Events, Heritage Events (As per Panjab University Youth Festival list)
2. Literary Events: Events as per Panjab University Youth Festival list and also include Independent thinking exercise, British parliamentary debate and Model United Nations

*\*If any student performs exceptionally well in any activity other than the activities mentioned above, college color will be awarded. But the decision making power will be of convocation committee chaired by the principal.*

### **COLLEGE COLOR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. A student representing University, Zone, State or Nation and obtaining the First position in above mentioned activities.
2. Every member of the team representing University, Zone, State or Nation and obtaining First position in above mentioned activities shall be eligible for College Color.
3. A student having scored at least 30 marks (for individual as well as team events) in all the three years combined. For calculating score of 30 marks, the proficiency of student in one particular activity shall be considered.
4. For calculation of marks, the participation in the outside competitions authorized by the College administration only, will be considered.
5. The scores criteria is as follows:

Note: For any team event, credit will be given to each of the team member separately.

6. i) College Color will also be given to the student who is adjudged Best Volunteer/ Camper in National Integration Camp, Advanced Youth Leadership Camps organized by the University or State Government and all those who participate in the Republic Day Parade.

ii) College Color will also be given to the students who have been members of the team adjudged as the Best Team in National Integration Camp, Preliminary and Advanced Youth Leadership Camps organized by the University or State Government.

7. **Eligibility for College Color in Independent Thinking Exercise** : For the purpose of College Color, this activity will be considered as a part of Literary Events only. After crossing successive levels, students who will be adjudged Best Independent Thinkers in the finals will be given credit of 3 points. Other finalists will be given credit of 2 points. Students who will make upto semi-finals but not upto finals will be given credit of 1 point.
8. **Eligibility for College Color in British Parliamentary Debate (BPD)** : For the purpose of College Color, this activity will be considered as a part of Literary Events only. The scoring criteria for both inter as well as intra college BPD competition shall remain the same as prescribed earlier for all other activities, except that there will be no credit for third prize in intra college BPD competition.
9. **Eligibility for College Color in Model United Nations (MUN)** : For the purpose of College Color, this activity will be considered as a part of Literary events only. Following criteria shall be followed for calculation of credit points for student's achievement in various MUN competitions:
