#### Partnering with Parents for Students' Progressive Advancement

Improvement in a student's academic performance and conduct is possible only with the collective efforts of the College as well as Parents. Supporting the idea of Parent-Teacher Partnership as a significant tool towards overall grooming of a student, the SACCM Parent Teacher Association (PTA) organized a formal interaction with parents on 13<sup>th</sup>April, 2023. The Meeting started with a Group Address by Principal Prof. (Dr.) Vishal Kumar, where in parents were briefed about the necessary parents' involvement and contribution to bring the students' performance to the expected heights. #### **PSYCHOLOGICAL INTERVENTIONS**

#### **Personality Assessment of Students**

To introduce the psychological intervention process for the benefit of students, assessment of students' personality is being carried out using The Big-Five test by the College Psychologist Ms. Lavanya Jain. This scale is based on the OCEAN model which explains personality attributes on five dimensions viz. Openness to experience, Conscientiousness, Extraversion, Agreeableness, and Neuroticism - reflecting high, low, and average scores on these dimensions – thereby helping the students to better understand themselves. The assessment was administered on all the students studying at SACCM. After becoming aware of their own personality traits, they will be in a better position to ask for their needs fulfilment, connect more easily with people, optimize their behaviour, and also choose their careers according to their personality type. Further, required interventions are planned in the upcoming academic sessions for helping them work on their weak and strong areas.

#### Icebreaking Session on "When to Reach Out?"

An icebreaker session was organised by College on 24th April 2023, which was about breaking stigma of reaching out to a mental health professional. A demo was given to use the EBSCO mobile app and the students were apprised of the fact that rather than the google search engine they can better use EBSCO to get unlimitedand authenticated content. Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Vishal Kumar congratulated the College Library Advisory Committee comprising Mr Anil Kumar (the Librarian), Dr Marinal Gupta and Ms Monica Sethi and Ms Pooja Mehta, for conceiving the demo session for the library users. He further commended the team members of EBSCO for conducting the training session and guiding the potential users about usage of EBSCO database.

#### **EXTENSION LECTURES**

In its pursuit to academic excellence, the College has been organizing interactions withindustryexpertsandpracticingprofessionals from different fields to provide practical exposure to its students and to keep them abreast with the recent developments. This exercise becomes vital as updating one's knowledge of a subjective y important, but at the same time noknowledge is complete unless aperson can relate it to practical lives as well.

#### **Extension lecture on Ethics, Education and Business**

The college organized an extension lecture on the theme 'Ethics, Education and Business' for the students of BCom Third Semester on 29<sup>th</sup>September, 2022. After the formal welcome by Principal Prof. (Dr.) Vishal Kumar, the resource person Dr. RimpiMehaniNe'e Chopra, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, Ramgarhia Girls College, Ludhianastarted her engrossing talk in an interactive way. Dr. Mehaniin her talk called attention to the true meaning of Education business which aids in the development of an individual and making one work-ready in dynamic environment. Accentuating on significance of business ethics, she elucidated that ethics reach far beyond the employee loyalty and shared thatpursuit for ethic-based functioninghelps businesses in following the right path and thus enhanceboth their corporate image and profitability. She asserted that corporations practicing business ethics value integrity shown by their employees and gain trust from key stakeholders such as investors and consumers as well. The lecture, co-ordinated by Dr. Manpreet Kaur, Dr. Aashish Garg and Dr. Priya Manchanda, was indeed a mind-stirring experience for the attendees.

#### Live session on Union Budget 2023-24

To keep the faculty and students updated with significant proceedings at opportune times, the college organised a live session on Union Budget 2023-24 which was presented by Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023. It was podcasted on digital screen for the students of B.ComSixth Semester and M.Com First Semester. After the budget was presented, Principal Prof (Dr.) Vishal Kumar discussed a brief review on the proposed budget by stating that Indian economy is on the right track and heading towards a bright future as the budget is balancing all the sectors of the economy. He highlighted the 7 priorities area i.e,. 'Saptrishi' of the budget. He emphasized that the success of digital payments needs to be replicated in the agriculture sector. Hence, the government has brought a scheme for digital agriculture infrastructure. He also stated that the middle class has been given some relief in terms of tweaks in the new income tax regime clearly pointing out that the government

wants a shift towards the new regime from the older one. Students also actively participated in the review and presented their views. The session turned out to be a very interactive one.

#### Extension Lecture on Entrepreneurship & You

An extension lecture was conducted on the topic 'Entrepreneurship & You'. The Keynote speaker was Prof. Rajiv Jain, Assistant Professor, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Technology (MAIT), Rohini. The lecture started with the inaugural speech by revered Principal Prof. (Dr) Vishal Kumar in which he advised students to pursue a career in entrepreneurship because it is more rewarding than traditional job searching especially post COVID-19 era. The purpose of the visit was well attained with a successful attempt to bridge the gap between classroom learning and practical orientation. Various services like eye care education, full eye checkups, free medicines were also distributed to the residents of the village. The camp aimed at providing free consultation and treatment to the villagers suffering from eye disorders. More than 100 people benefitted from this camp.

There was a spectacular Nukkad Natak performance by NSS volunteers for public awareness regarding 'Drug Abuse'. Volunteers urged the viewers to quit drugs as drug addiction can lead to a range of mental and physical health problems. ## Day 6- Hands-On Training Session on CPR Technique

On the 6th day of NSS Camp, a hands-on session on first aid and basic life support was conducted by Dr. Manender Kumar from Fortis hospital, Ludhiana. It focused on how to provide first aid in wounds, bleeding, musculoskeletal injury, burns, poisoning, bites, drowning, fainting, seizures, and unconsciousness. He also familiarized the volunteers with recognition of signs of sudden cardiac arrest, heart attack, stroke and how to handle such a situation before taking the patient to a medical facility. Proper first aid always comes across as a big respite when handling different health and medical emergencies. Besides saving the injured person's life, it helps make the recovery process faster, saves huge healthcare costs, and prevents the likelihood of injury from getting worse.

The NSS unit also coordinated a free Eye Examination Camp for the occupants of Village Jhande. ## **EDUCATION MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE -QUAL CAMPUS**

The College has a firm belief that Information Technology is a catalyst in the teaching learning process. Hence, the College has deployed a web/internet-based Education Management Software Qual Campus through which students and members of faculty monitor daily activities such as attendance, timetable, lecture notes, assignments, examination schedules, results, reference material, online fee payments etc. The College Library has also gone on automated working through this software. The ERP also provides solutions to many other facilities for administrative support. Essentially, the software acts as an effective

interface between the college and the students, college and staff.

## **COLLEGE LIBRARY**

SACCM library is the nucleus of the college as it contains all the critical and updated resources related to academics and non-academics that make learning effective. A total of 5211 books are there in the stock in Library for the reference of students and Faculty. In addition to this, 29 Journals and Magazines have been subscribed to. Further, the College has also subscribed to 10 Newspapers. This resource hub of the college has the membership of N-List programme of INFLIBNET Centre which provides vast access to approximately 6,150 e-journals and 31,64,309 e-books. Considering the optimum and effective usage of these e-resources, a new dedicated computer Lab consisting of 10 high-end systems with the latest configuration and internet facility has been established in the library. To keep pace with e-technology, the college has automated the library through web/internet-based Education Management Software QualCampus and its collection can also be searched through Web OPAC. OPAC Kiosk is available for searching the books through QualCampus and users can locate the books easily. Besides this, a case study bank and repository of faculty publications is kept in the library for reference of faculty and students. Reprographic facility is also given to the students in the College library for effective utilization of books, project reports, magazines, journals and periodicals. Internet, printing, scanningand computer facilities are also available for the students and staff members.

#### SMART AND AIR-CONDITIONED CLASSROOMS

The College has already got well-furnished, AC fitted comfy classrooms to accommodate 70 students and 40 students of B. Com and BBA classes. All Classrooms were already equipped with ICT facilities like LCD projectors and audio-visual aids required for effective teaching. Now, the college has installed interactive smart boards to enhance the interactivity and better utility of the boards for students as well as teachers. Smart Classrooms are going to be a good resource for the 'Blended Teaching' mode as an option in the times to come considering the new education policy.
